| Arrival in Host Country: | Entry regulations determined by CZE Government – actual info here : Prime responsibility lies with travelers. Before traveling to the Czech Republic, foreigners traveling must <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • fill in an arrival form; Please check all details carefully before leaving the Home Country. |

| Teams: | No restrictions by transportation in own / rented vehicles. Teams are responsible for their own transportation throughout and are advised to make full use of disinfectant wipes pre- and post- travel, and suitable mask discipline within their vehicles. |
| Officials: | No restrictions. |

| Testing regime: | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No testing at the venue • All SE officials and all team delegation has to approve their health by following before their the first entrance to the stadium: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Fully vaccination (2 weeks after the second dose in a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines, or 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine) ○ Negative PCR test 48 hours prior entrance to the Czech Republic (tests can be arranged in the city of Prague, please contact the COVID-19 Officer Vojtěch Albrecht albrecht@softball.cz) ○ Proof of recovering from COVID-19 in the 180 days prior to the start of the tournament. <p>The national COVID-19 vaccination certificate is the only proof document to be used. It is possible to use both the digital version on a mobile phone or the paper version – both need to have QR Code.</p> |

| | All team members will be checked before their first game at the tournament. No exception will be admitted. |
| In case of a positive test: | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prior to the entrance in the Host Country: the person shall not travel to the event. • On the day of arrival in the Host Country: the positive person will be isolated and tested 72 hours after the first positive test. <i>It is advisable that the teams agree with the hotels upon a 'isolation room' for potential positive person.</i> |

| Hotels: | <p>It is all Teams' responsibility to be aware of their accommodation's rules, and to comply.</p> <p>IF Teams share Hotel with Officials there must be no contact between individuals from each group unless absolute necessary, and then only with 2m distancing, with masks.</p> |
| At venues: | Teams will be checked before the first game in the tournament. |

| Spectators: | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Spectators are allowed up to 5.000 people • No tickets – free entrance <p>To access the venue, it will be necessary for spectators to be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • fully vaccinated • or to have a negative PCR test certificate (taken a maximum of 7 days prior to the entrance) • or a negative antigen test certificate (taken a maximum of 72 hours prior to the entrance). |
| Media & accreditations: | <p>To access the venue, it will be necessary for all accredited media to be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • fully vaccinated • or to have a negative PCR test certificate (taken a maximum of 7 days prior to the entrance) • or a negative antigen test certificate (taken a maximum of 72 hours prior to the entrance). <p>Please refer to SE Media Officer Natalie Tauchenova (tauchenova@softball.cz) and SE Communications Director Elda Ghilardi (eghilardi@wbsceurope.org)</p> |
