

MASTERS Covid Bulletin

This Bulletin updates the general SE Covid Regulations with specific information for participants in the Men's Softball European Masters Cup and the Women's Softball European Masters Cup 2021.

Issued: Oct 15, 2021

Travel:

Leaving Home country:	Exit requirements determined by home Government. This is under the whole responsibility of travelling Teams / individuals.
Arrival in Host Country:	Entry regulations determined by ESP Government re 'Green Passport' etc – https://www.mscbs.gob.es/profesionales/saludPublica/ccayes/alertasActual/nCov/spth.htm Prime responsibility lies with Travelers. Before traveling to Spain, foreigners traveling must <ul style="list-style-type: none"> fill in a sanitary control form: https://spth.gob.es/ Please check all details carefully before leaving the Home Country, and ensure all team members follow current requirements.

Transportation:

Teams:	No restrictions by transportation in own / rented vehicles. Teams are responsible for their own transportation throughout, and are advised to make full use of disinfectant wipes pre- and post- travel, and suitable mask discipline within their vehicles.
Officials:	No restrictions

Testing:

Testing regime:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The presentation of a vaccination passport "Green Passport" is mandatory at the Technical Meeting. Otherwise, it will be obligatory to present a negative PCR (72 hours prior the entrance) or antigen test (24 hours prior the entrance) certificate.
In case of a positive test:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Prior to the entrance in the Host Country: the person should not travel to the event. <i>If occurring at the event, it is advisable that the teams agree with their hotels upon a 'isolation room' for potential positive person.</i> <i>Room-mate(s) should also take a test to demonstrate non-infection.</i>

Bubble arrangements:

Hotels:	It is all Teams' responsibility to be aware of their accommodation's rules, and to comply. IF Teams share Hotel with Officials there must be no contact between individuals from each group unless absolute necessary, and then only with 2m distancing, with masks.
At venues:	Team Covid Officers are responsible to Event Covid Officer for Team members complying with all venue distancing regulations. Masks continue to be used inside, including Hotels and shops, but no restrictions in an outside environment, including ceremonies.
During games:	Balls will be cleaned / administered by the UIC / TC.

Spectators & Media:

Spectators:	No restrictions.
Media & accreditations:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • People coming from abroad: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Leaving Home Country and entering Spain is under the whole responsibility of the individuals following the rules and laws of both Home Country and Host Country. ○ Entering event's venue: with a negative PCR (72 hours prior the entrance) or antigen test (24 hours prior the entrance) certificate. <p>Please refer to SE Media Officer: Communications Director Elda Ghilardi (eghilardi@wbsceurope.org).</p> <p>Photographers and other Media personnel are not required to wear masks in an outside environment.</p>

Return requirements:

Exit requirements:	Set by Host Government. Primarily team responsibility, assisted by update advice from Host Federation, also expediting any test required prior to departure.
Re-entry to Home Country:	Wholly Team / Individual responsibility.
