1. Welcome, quorum and opening by Co Presidents:

• Current situation with events in the Divisions

Each person gave a short description of what is happening in their specific countries as to possible start dates for their national competitions.

SWE – moved to June 21st, new decision about possible further postponement one month in advance. No more than 50 people allowed in a location, youth sports allowed to practice and play localy.

DEN – Training outdoors, no start date for League play.

NED – U12 training, 12-18 train in groups of 10 and adults possibly May 13 with hopeful start of Leagues in June.

ITA – still in lockdown. Training only alone. Start is on June 14 League play.

BEL – 3rd of May complete lockdown. Big events only after September 1.

FRA – Lockdown until May 11 from now. Looking at August possibly training in group's of 10, and maybe September League play.

ISR – training in groups of 10, possible start of League play July 1.

CZE – training in groups of 10, on May 11 can play Leagues with events of 100 people.

CRO – Practive in froups, and looking good for May 30 League play.

BUL - Practicing and ready for League play in June.

ESP – nothing scheduled until now, still lockdown.

Co-ordination of future steps

<u>Softball Europe</u>: Cancelled all their Championships except the U15 for now but will be after September 1 if at all. Waiting for information from the KNBSB.

No Qualifiers for this year, so the decision was not so difficult.

<u>Baseball Europe:</u> Cancelled all Cups and have postponements for a few Championships which are qualifiers. U18 and Seniors B-Pool moved to the end of September/October. U15 and U23 Qualifiers there is no decision yet.

DS – we need common position of both Divisions to face this situation.

For example; if a country cannot make it to a qualifier we need in order to preserve fairness a decision to cancel the event.

Will there be any consideration as to finances that country cannot come because of lack of finances.

Another example: BB5 situation and the qualifier for the U18 WC in Mexico.

Discussion on the options and what needs to be decided.

MS – suggests to take time to make final decisions as the situation keeps changing all over the world.

Unanimous Decision:

No International Competitions until September 1, 2020 with cut-off deadline is June 30, 2020.
